It is with great pleasure we welcome you to the 2006 Taiji Legacy International Martial Arts Championships, celebrating the Year of the Dog. This event is hosted by the USA Chin Woo Federation and sanctioned by the US Traditional Kung Fu Wushu Federation. The Taiji Legacy will be unique in its own, gathering all styles of taiji and kungfu from all parts of the world, making it a spectacular event. Northern Praying Mantis, Eagle Claw, Pa Chi, Chin Woo Events, Choy Lay Fut, Wing Chun Wooden Dummy, & San Shou, etc.

NOVICE EVENTS are available for competitors who are competing for the first time. Competitors can also enter this event if they wish to exhibit their form and be scored but not ranked. All Novice competitors will receive an award and a medal for their display of martial art spirit. Novice events are listed in section 7 of the registration form.

To Plano Convention Centre

From North, take 75 South to Spring Creek Pkwy exit. (From South, take 75 North to Spring Creek Pkwy exit.) Go east on Spring Creek Pkwy and the Plano Centre will be on the right (SW corner of Jupiter Rd).

From Hotel, take 75 North to Spring Creek Pkwy. Go east on Spring Creek Pkwy and the Plano Centre will be on the right (SW corner of Jupiter Rd).

To the Host Hotels

From North, take 75 South to 15th Street (exit 29) and U-turn to the service road to go north. (From South, take 75 North to Park Blvd exit (exit 29A).)Turn right on E. Central Pkwy (immediately after Denny's). Holiday Inn will be on the right, and Best Western will be on the left.

FORMS GRAND CHAMPIONS CRITERIA

Internal Forms Grand Champion:

Requirements: Advanced level, Adult or Executive division; competitor must rank 1st in **ALL** of the following required events:

- 1 of the 5 major Taiji Barehand events (Chen, Yang, Wu (Hao), Wu, Sun)
- 1 Internal Barehand event (other Taiji or other internal form; Open Events don't apply)
- 1 Internal Weapon event (sword or other weapon; Open Events don't apply)

Note: Group events do not apply. Finalists must do Taiji Straightsword on Sunday.

Traditional External Forms Grand Champion:

Requirements: Advanced level, Adult or Executive division; competitor must rank 1st in **ALL** of the following required events:

- 1 Traditional Barehand event (Open events don't apply)
- 1 Traditional Short Weapon event (straight sword or sabre; Open Events don't apply)
- 1 Traditional Long Weapon event (staff or spear; Open Events don't apply)
- 1 Traditional Individual Other Form or Weapon (must sign up under the Traditional Kungfu Category of External Events. Competitor CANNOT do the same form as in the other qualifier events for Grand Champion)

Note: Group events, 2-3 Person Sets, & Chin Woo events do not apply. Finalists will do ONE external barehand routine of their choice on **Sunday.**

Junior Forms Grand Champion:

Requirements: Kids or Juniors division (Level: 2 years or more) or Advanced Teen division; competitors may compete in as many individual events as they want. Group events, 2-3 Person Sets, & Chin Woo Forms are excluded. 10 points are given for 1st place, 7 points for 2nd, and 5 points for 3rd. Highest total points in Kids, Juniors, and Teens divisions will compete against each other in ONE Barehand form of choice on **Sunday** to determine the winner.

Chin Woo Forms Grand Champion:

Requirements: "16 years old or older" division for Chin Woo forms; competitor must compete in ALL 5 compulsory Chin Woo forms:

- Gong Li Quan (Strength Boxing)
- Qun Yang Gun (Sheep Flocking Pole)
 Wu Hu Qiang (5 Tiger Spear)
- Jie Quan (Connecting Fist)
- Ba Gua Dao (Baqua Broadsword)

10 points are given for 1st place, 7 points for 2nd, and 5 points for 3rd. Highest total points determines winner. Tie breaker: Reperform Jie Quan.

Wing Chun Grand Champion:

Requirements: Adult division, Advanced level; competitor must compete in **ALL** 4 required events:

- Wooden Dummy Form
- Chi-sau
- Wing Chun Hand Form (Sil Lim Tao, Chum Kiu, or Bil Gee)
- Sparring (competitor may choose either continuous sparring or san-shou)

10 points are given for 1st place, 7 points for 2nd, and 5 points for 3rd. Highest total points determines winner. Tie breaker: One barehand form of choice on Sunday.

Modern Wushu Grand Champion:

Requirements: Advanced level, Adult or Executive division; competitor must rank 1st in **ALL** of the following required events:

- 1 Wushu Barehand event (Changguan or Nanguan Open events don't apply)
- 1 Wushu Short Weapon event (Sword, Sabre, or Nandao; Open Events don't apply)
- 1 Wushu Long Weapon event (Staff, Spear, or Nangun; Open Events don't apply)
- 1 Individual Other Form or Weapon (must sign up under the Modern Wushu Category of External Events. Competitor CANNOT do the same form as in the other qualifier events for Grand Champion)

Note: Group events, 2-3 Person Sets, & Chin Woo events do not apply. Finalists will do either Changguan or Nanguan on **Sunday**.

*Only one award will be given for each Grand Champion category (male & female do not have separate awards) (6 awards total).

GRAND CHAMPION FINALS - TIME LIMITS

Internal: 3 min minimum, 5 min maximum External: 45 sec minimum, 2 min maximum

OUTLINE OF RULES & TIME LIMITS

Traditional & Modern Wushu Forms

• 30 secs. minimum (45 secs. for Advanced levels)

• 2 min. maximum

All Tai Chi forms (includes 24, 48, & combined 72)

• 3 min. minimum

• 3 min. 30 secs. maximum

(42 Step competitors must do complete form - b/w 5-6 min)

Tai Chi Sword & Other Internal Weapons

(wooden swords are allowed if 1 lb or more)

- 1 min. 30 secs. minimum
- 3 min. 30 secs. maximum

Other Internal & External Forms

45 secs, minimum

• 2 min. 30 secs. maximum

Musical Group Events: 1 min. 30 sec. minimum, 5 min. maximum (Taiji Form & Taiji Weapon); 45 sec. minimum, 2 min. maximum (Other Forms & Weapons: Internal, External, Wushu)

Wing Chun Wooden Dummy: 2 min max (Intermediate), 2min 30 sec max (Advanced). Intermediate performs first 4 sections; Advanced performs full set.

For Tai Chi, Internal forms, and Musical group events, the competitor will be given an audible signal before the last 30 sec. of the time limit. The competitor will then have the remaining 30 sec. to complete the form.

For all forms competition, a deduction of *one-tenth* point will be taken for each 5 sec. interval outside the time limit.

Reaction skills:

- Restricted-Step Push Hands two 60 sec. rounds with a 15 sec. break in between rounds
- · Moving Push Hands one round of 90 sec. PUSHING TIME
- Point Sparring one round of 90 sec.
- Continuous Sparring two 30 sec. rounds with a 15 sec. break in between rounds
- Weapons Sparring two 60 sec. rounds with a 1 min. break in between rounds
- Shuai Chiao three 2 min. rounds with 1 min. break in between rounds
- Chi Sau two 90 sec. rounds, with a 30 sec. break in between rounds
- San Shou three 2 min. rounds with a 1 min, break in between rounds

RE-PERFORMING:

Any performer may begin his/her form again, without penalty, should that competitor be interrupted by uncontrollable circumstances. Re-performing due to forgetfulness, broken weapons, etc. will be permitted with a full 1/2 (one half) point deduction from the total score. This will not be permitted more than once.

SCORING:

Scoring will be based on performance & level. The ranges are:

Beginner: 6.5 - 7.5
Intermediate: 7.5 - 8.5
Advanced: 8.5 - 9.5
Very Advanced: 9.5 - 9.99

5 scores will be given in which the highest and lowest score will be dropped to calculate the final score. In the event of a tie score, all 5 scores will be used. In case of another tie, both athletes shall receive the same awards.




